• Ash Wednesday/Valentines Day:

During Lent we are invited, as Catholics, to step outside of our day-to-day routines and into a formal time of personal preparation for Easter. The Church calls us to a sort of spiritual "spring cleaning"; to participate in practices that help us turn back to God.

CASH CALENDAR UPDATE - AGLC Licence #666110

We are midway through our cash calendar month and it's been exciting to draw and post names daily. Our final ticket sales ended at 335 tickets sold which totalled \$6,700 in sales. We are handing out \$4,800 in prizes which left a profit to the playground fund in the amount of \$1,900. We have had 3 winners so far donate their winnings back to the playground fund which leaves us with a current profit of \$2,300.

We will be announcing the top 2 selling students and class at our next meeting at the end of the month and they will receive a JJN swag bag and the top selling class will receive a pizza party paid for by Families and Friends of JJN.

Our bank balance is currently **\$28,880.85.** The total earmarked for the playground as of today's date is **\$23,033.81** which leaves us with a balance of **\$5,847.04** in our account.
