

J. J. Nearing Catholic Elementary School Grade Two Supply List 2024/2025

If you have already made a purchase from School Start for your grade two supplies it is not necessary for you to purchase the following list.

Please be sure each crayon and all supplies have your child's name on it and is placed in a Ziploc bag.

- 6 Duo-tangs (1 each purple, red, dark blue, orange, green, & yellow)
- 1 Plastic twin pocket folder
- 1 Hilroy Studio Pro Sketch Book 8 1/2 X 11, white 100 Sheets
- 1 Hilroy exercise book 40 pages no coil
- 1 Hilroy exercise book 72 pages $\frac{1}{2}$ plain, $\frac{1}{2}$ lined
- 3 Glue sticks (40g large)
- 2 Red pens
- 1 Black Sharpie marker chisel tip
- 1 Package Mr Sketch Markers
- 1 Crayola 12 fine tipped washable felt markers
- 1 Crayola or Laurentian 24 colored pencil crayons (pre-sharpened)
- 1 Crayola 24 watercolor paints washable (can use from grade one supplies)
- 10 Whiteboard markers fine tip (blue or black)
- 2 Whiteboard eraser (small) or sport sock
- 4 White erasers (large)
- 12 Canadian made HB pre-sharpened pencils (please do not label)
- 3 Large Ziploc bags (please do not label)
- 4 Extra large Ziploc bags (please do not label)
- 2 Highlighters (fine-tipped)
- 1 Staedtler pencil sharpener (with cover)
- 1 Fiskars scissors (children's size, pointed)
- 1 Large box of Kleenex
- 1 Canister of wet hand wipes
- 1 Long plastic pencil box (12 x 33 cm) or large plastic pencil containers no more than 12 cm high, that can hold most of the supplies)
- 1 Knapsack (durable and large)
- 1 Set of earphones (please ensure that they are comfortable and fit your child properly) (please label)
- 1 Pair of indoor running shoes non-marking & non-skid (MUST tie tightly) Please no laces unless your child can tie independently
- ** We encourage the recycling of supplies from previous years wherever possible.**

In an effort to help children keep their items and reduce the amount of Lost & Found items, **we are asking parents to label** their children's coats, boots, shoes, water bottles, lunch kits, backpacks, mittens, etc. If you require labels, we have had some parents suggest "Mabels Labels" at <u>www.mabelslabels.com</u>. These labels are reported to be excellent as they stick to clothing or any surface very well even after going through the dishwasher or washing machine.
