applied for the \$125,000.00 from the province.

- extra \$40,000 from the city was more than we were expecting as we pushed a bit further. Being said, that gives us 18 months timeline to have it belt.
- Kendall has just applied for the \$125,000 from the province. We will hear a response from this in March.
